Important Message for TXBCU Credit Card Holders

To meet upcoming industry requirements, current Texas Bridge Credit Union MasterCard <u>credit card</u> holders will be issued a replacement credit card with a new number and expiration date. This will <u>not</u> impact MasterCard debit cards.

Although credit card numbers will change, credit limit, account balance, history and related information will remain unchanged. Since the credit cards have a new account number, members will need to update their new card number with merchants that are set up with automatic billing including subscription services. These replacement cards are **not** related to fraud so please know your personal information is secure.

MasterCard credit card holders are encouraged to activate their new card once it's received in the mail as current credit cards will deactivate on June 24, 2021.

Protecting Your Identity & Money

Fraudsters continually find new ways to trick innocent people out of money or personal identifiable information. Whether it's an imposter scam – impersonating a financial institution employee, a grandchild, debt collector, etc. – or stealing someone's identity, these fraudsters know how to pull it off.

Using common channels like emails, texts, phone calls, and social networks; fraudsters typically disguise their identity while retrieving your confidential information. Fraudsters will use several different social engineering techniques to acquire sensitive information such as usernames, passwords, and account or payment card details. Common warning signs include:

- Don't always trust the display name criminals will spoof the email name to appear to be a legitimate sender
- Check for misspelled words, bad grammar, and/or typos within message content
- Be cautious of clicking links and opening attachments DON'T CLICK unless you are confident of the sender or expecting the attachment
- Asking you to share a one-time passcode sent to your device (when they called you)
- Check the salutation many legitimate businesses will use a personal salutation
- Do not provide personal information when asked
- Be suspicious of "urgent" or "immediate" response needed or "unauthorized login attempt" of your account
- Don't believe everything you see. Brand logos, names and addresses may appear legitimate
- Monitor the sender's email address for suspicious URLs & domains often using similar letters and numbers
- If something seems suspicious; contact that source with a new email or phone call, rather than just hitting reply
- Always, be wary of tempting offers

Recognizing scams can be difficult but you can minimize the potential impact by knowing what to look for, taking the right action steps and remaining vigilant.
