Hurricane Season Preparedness

The 2022 Atlantic hurricane season begins on June 1, 2022 and it's predicted to be an above average year in regard to storms. Natural disasters damage thousands of homes and devastate the livelihoods of families every day, but you can take time now to prepare.

Be Prepared, Stay Prepared

Know Your Risk - Sign up for your community's emergency warning system. Register to receive Reverse Alert emergency notifications from the City of Corpus Christi at www.ccctexas.com. The Emergency Alert System (EAS) and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Weather Radio also provide emergency alerts.

Gather Supplies - Keep in mind each family member's needs, gathering supplies for at least three days. Now is the time to stock up on items such as food and water, non-perishable foods, first-aid supplies, prescriptions, pet supplies, flashlights and batteries. Don't forget to charge electronics you may need. Also, keep an adequate amount of cash on hand in case ATM networks and other forms of electronic payment are unavailable.

Personal Safety – Create a "go kit" that includes items like hand sanitizer, face masks, wipes, and liquid soap.

Secure Documents - Remember to secure copies of important personal documents including financial information. Filing for government assistance requires documentation. Be sure to keep documents in a secure location and take them with you if you need to evacuate.

Protect Your Property - Shutter your home as needed, review your flood insurance policy (or sign up for one) and declutter drains and gutters. Most homeowner and renter insurance policies do not cover flood damage. A flood insurance policy generally does not take effect until 30 days after purchase, so be sure to maintain your policy.

Make Your Evacuation Plan - Be familiar with your recommended evacuation route and shelter locations. Discuss and practice drills for your evacuation plan with your family each year.

Planning ahead with the above-listed steps will help you be prepared for any storms that may impact our community.
