## **Hurricane Season - Be Ready Today!**

The 2025 hurricane season has begun and forecasters predict an above normal season with 13-19 named storms. Of those, 6-10 are forecast to be hurricanes including 3-5 major hurricanes (Category 3 or higher).

Information is key when planning and preparing for an emergency. All Texas Bridge Credit Union members are encouraged to sign up for Reverse Alert notifications. The City of Corpus Christi and Nueces County have partnered to deliver critical information to residents regarding current conditions, expected impacts, and protective actions to keep



themselves and their loved ones safe through Reverse Alert.

#### **Develop an Emergency Communication Plan**

In case family members are separated from one another during a disaster, have a plan for getting back together. Ask an out-of-state relative or friend to serve as the "family contact." After a disaster, it's often easier to call long distance. Make sure everyone in the family knows the name, address, and phone number of the contact person.

Make sure that all family members know how to respond after a hurricane. Teach family members how and when to turn off gas, electricity, and water. Teach children how and when to call 9-1-1, police, or the fire department and which radio and/or television stations to tune into for emergency information.

#### **Make Arrangements for Family Members with Special Needs**

Do you or anyone you know need some assistance during times of an emergency event? The state of Texas offers the STEAR program. The STEAR program is a free registry that provides local emergency planners and emergency responders with additional information on the needs in their community. 
